Dear Plant and Hire Aid Alliance Member

As we enter our fourth year of providing humanitarian support to the people of Ukraine, there are glimmers of hope emerging, with both sides engaging in discussions on how to bring the war to an end. In the meantime, however, the devastation and human suffering continue, with millions displaced or affected by the ongoing conflict.

One of the key highlights this year was the charity lunch hosted by JCB at the JCB Golf and Country Club. It was attended by 100 people and together we raised enough funds to purchase 80 generators for community shelters, medical centres, schools and public buildings, all of which have been impacted by frequent power outages caused by Russian attacks on energy infrastructure. I'd like to express my sincere thanks to JCB for supporting this event, and also to Genpower for supplying the generators.

Another highlight was the despatch of 255 pallets of hospital-grade Clinell wipes, which were used not only in hospitals but also served troops on the front line. In addition, 12 artic loads of Astroturf, amounting to nearly 200,000 square metres, were sent to reinforce frontline trenches against missile attacks and to refurbish school playgrounds damaged by drone strikes.

Our Christmas appeal was another resounding success, involving four 'wrapathons' held in Ipswich, Bedford, Swindon and Bath. During these events, 14,000 gifts were wrapped by nearly 300 volunteers as part of a consignment totalling 20,000 gifts, bringing our three-year total to 65,000.

This Christmas, once again, we will be sending wrapped gifts to displaced children living in the war zone or in orphanages, whose parents are either fighting for their country's freedom or have tragically been lost due to the war. Wrapped gifts should be sent to Ardent Hire by close of business on Friday, 5th December. The trucks will depart for Ukraine the following week.

At the time of writing, the value of goods in kind co-ordinated and shipped by the plant and plant hire industry now stands at £10 million. Now is not the time to lose heart—especially when so many are weary of the conflict and support may not feel as fashionable as it once did.



Flour Donation March 2024

Westmill Foods donates 11 tonnes of flour which are delivered to Ipswich and forwarded to Ukrainian towns on the front line.





<u>Astroturf Appeal</u> March 2024 – March 2025

- Donations from Astroturf suppliers fund 12 x 40 foot artics of Astroturf to reinforce defences on the front line and repair school playgrounds that have been damaged by missile attacks. Members of the PHA fund the transport to Ukraine.
- Each load consisted of 16,000 sq m of turf. At an average of £25 per sq m this amounts to £4.8m of value-in-kind. Thanks to <u>www.tacklingmatters.com</u> for their donation of turf.










Clinell Hospital Wipes April 2024

200kVA Generator November 2024

The Plant and Hire Alliance purchases a 200kVA generator for an outpatient building in Oleksandria using funds raised by Friends of Oleksandriya. The generator is shipped to Ardent's Ipswich depot and shipped to Ukraine as part of the consignment of Christmas gifts.
















Bath Abbey Concert February 2025


